Corvina, rondinella

Full-bodied, ripe, supple and well-balanced with aromas of dark chocolate and roasted nuts with a long finish.

Forest fruits married with cocoa, vanilla, hints of black pepper and

Syrah, cabernet sauvignon

Well balanced with vanilla oak and spice on the nose. Rich, ripe black fruit on the palate, notably blackberry and cassis.

Gillardi Barolo, Piemonte, Italy 2015/2016 | £79

Nebbiolo

A hint of leather on the nose gives way to cherry, blackberries and notes of cedar. An elegant but complex finish.

Château Bellegrave Pomerol, Bordeaux, France, 2011 | £110

Merlot, Cabernet Franc

Discreet nose, giving ripe plum, cherries and touches of fruit tea. A soft and measured extraction opens up the tannins to deliver a plush, warm, mouthfeel, far more generously than expected.





Rosé Wine

Este Rosé, Portugal | £25

Vinhão, borracal, espadeiro

Fragrant aromas of strawberries, raspberries, and a hint of citrus, give the vibrant acidity its subtle spritz and minerality.

Grenache, cinsault and syrah

Crisp and dry with flavours of red berries and strawberries with a refreshing, clean but moorish finish.

Folc Rosé, Kent, England | £38

Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier, Chardonnay, Bacchus
Stunning example of English rosé with notes of bright peach and pink grapefruit, warm cranberry, and mulled spice.
Perfectly balanced.

Mas de Cadenet, Provence, France | £42

Grenache, Cinsault, Syrah

Pale salmon pink, the mouth is lively with layers of gooseberry and fruit drops with elegant texture and a surprising length. Outstanding.

Hugel Schoelhammer, Alsace, France 2012 | £165 Riesling

Famille Hugel's greatest expression of riesling, the perfume is complex, fruity, floral and combines perfectly with its magnificent saline minerality. Taught and lively, the freshness underlines its generosity and vinosity.

Bouchard Père & Fils Chassagne - Montrachet, Burgundy, France, 2018 | £185

Chardonnay

An intense bouquet, developing flavours of lemon and apple, entwined with subtle notes of vanilla. Ample and silky on the palate with a long and toasty finish, cut perfectly with vivid acidity.

Château Grand-Puy-Lacoste, Pauillac Bordeaux, France 2018 | £170

Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot

Classic and firm in its style, great depth of colour with tobacco leaf, cedar and spice. Full bodied with a piquant crunch, for perfect length.

Anakota 'Helena Dakota', Sonoma, CA, USA, 2017 |

Cabernet Sauvignon

Dense in colour with immediate aromas of violets and coffee, giving way to a smoky leather palate. French oak allows supple tannins to frame an earthiness usually associated with Bordeaux, but the dark Napa fruit wins you over with its intense finish.

A superb example of this vibrant wine; lots of fresh lemon with notes of white flowers, and brilliant acidity.
